

Master's degree program applicants should have a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent degree to a Bachelor's degree (or above) in China.

Please submit all the documents listed below to the application system:

- · Personal statement
- Curriculum Vitae (Both English and Chinese)
- Degree certificate and degree authentication
- Academic transcript
- Language Proficiency Test score report
- Two academic recommendation letters
- Passport (personal ordinary-type passport): Passport bio page
- Students applying for the TCMiBA Program also need to meet the requirements:
- (1) Academic transcript (English)
- (2) Valid TOEFL (at least 100 and above) or IELTS (at least 7 and above)
- * For applicants whose undergraduate or graduate degree was awarded in a country in which English is not the official language.
- (3) Three recommendation letters (Bilingual in English and Chinese or English Only) in total

Scholarships

Chinese Government Scholarship (CGS)

The Full CGS usually covers tuition fees, free university dormitory or accommodation subsidy, *stipend, and comprehensive medical insurance. The Partial CGS includes one or some items from the Full CGS coverage. Annual Review is strictly required for all CGS holders.

* The distribution of CGS will be adjusted according to the policies and regulations of higher authorities.

Schools/departments select Tuition Scholarship candidates from outstanding pre-admitted applicants.
