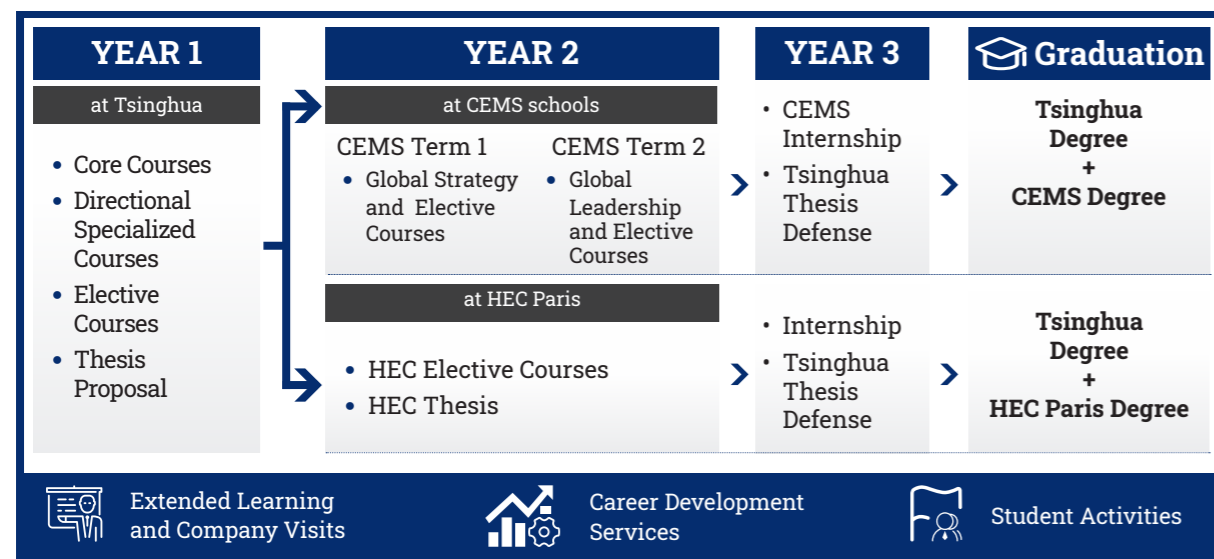

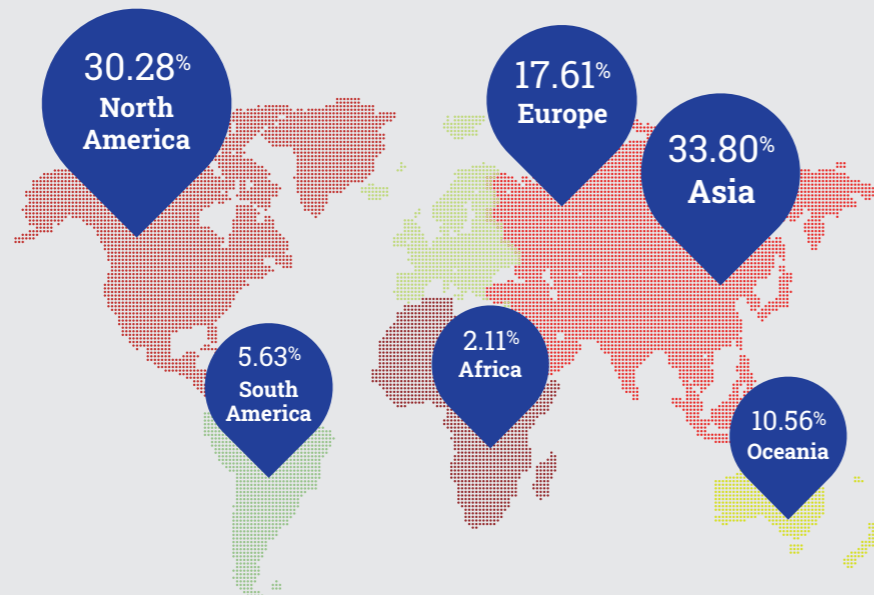

## CEMS Club



Each school also has a CEMS Club, run by CEMS students, which animates student life through events and activities involving CEMS alumni and Corporate/Social Partners, supporting both home school students and incoming students to make the most of their local experience. For the precise requirements, please consult the admission information on the Graduate Admission Website of Tsinghua University for the year.

### Qualification of Applicants

 Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens with a valid personal ordinary-type passport.

 Master's degree program applicants should have a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent degree to a Bachelor's degree (or above) in China.

### Application Documents

Please submit all the documents listed below to the application system:

- Personal statement
  - Curriculum Vitae (Both English and Chinese)
  - Degree certificate and degree authentication
  - Academic transcript
  - Language Proficiency Test score report
  - Two academic recommendation letters
  - Passport (personal ordinary-type passport): Passport bio page
  - Students applying for the TCMiBA Program also need to meet the requirements:
    - (1) Academic transcript (English)
    - (2) Valid TOEFL (at least 100 and above) or IELTS (at least 7 and above)
- \* For applicants whose undergraduate or graduate degree was awarded in a country in which English is not the official language.
- (3) Three recommendation letters (Bilingual in English and Chinese or English Only) in total
