- 4 No requirements for undergraduate major.

Tuition Fee

RMB 30,000/per year

Students enrolled with CEMS Master in International Management or HEC dual degree program are exempt from tuition fees of partners schools, and only pay tuition fees of Tsinghua University.

Scholarships

Chinese Government Scholarship (CGS)

The Full CGS usually covers tuition fees, free university dormitory or accommodation subsidy, *stipend, and comprehensive medical insurance. The Partial CGS includes one or some items from the Full CGS coverage. Annual Review is strictly required for all CGS holders.


