Qualifications

Non-Chinese citizens with valid personal ordinary-type passports.
- 2

Applicant should have a Bachelor's Degree or an equivalent degree to a Bachelor's Degree (or above) in China.
- 3

In good health and of good character, be well-behaved and be willing to abide by China's laws and regulations, as well as Tsinghua's rules.
- 4

No requirements for undergraduate major.

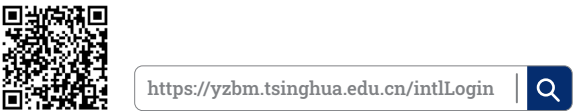

Scholarships

Chinese Government Scholarship (CGS)

The Full CGS usually covers tuition fees, free university dormitory or accommodation subsidy, *stipend, and comprehensive medical insurance. The Partial CGS includes one or some items from the Full CGS coverage. Annual Review is strictly required for all CGS holders.
